The 2019 Christmas Dinner in the Valley is in the books! God has once again richly blessed this ministry and this church by allowing us to be His hands and feet to many in our community on Christmas Day!

MEALS: Approximately 800 meals were served - both delivered throughout the community and surrounding areas and served here in the Worship Center. We did have some leftover food which was donated to Chuck Wagon Church for their soup kitchen.

VOLUNTEERS: We were so blessed by an abundance of volunteers - many from our Harvest family but also many from the community. People came and went throughout the day, but we estimate we had over 150 volunteers that served in some form or fashion.

DONATIONS: All expenses for the meal were completely covered between donations that were given and budgeted support from the church. The total donations that were given over the last couple of months in the offering boxes plus what was given during the meal totaled \$1,440.95.
